Reference Images:

Start with images of the character you're cosplaying. Include multiple angles and any specific details you focused on. This helps the judges

see how closely you've adhered to the character's design.

MATERIALS LIST:

Provide a detailed list of the materials and tools you used. Mention any special fabrics, paints, or techniques that contributed to the overall look. This shows your resourcefulness and understanding of materials.

WORK-IN-PROGRESS PHOTOS:

Document your process with photos at different stages. This could include patterns, sewing progress, painting, prop construction, and any modifications you made along the way. These images help judges see the evolution of your work.

TECHNIQUES AND PROCESSES:

Explain the techniques you used, such as sewing, embroidery, foam crafting, 3D printing, or electronics. Go into detail about any challenges you faced and how you overcame them. This is your chance to highlight your skills and any innovative solutions you came up with.

TIME MANAGEMENT AND CHALLENGES:

If relevant, discuss how you managed your time and any major hurdles you had to overcome. This section shows your ability to plan and adapt, which are important aspects of cosplay creation.

FINAL PHOTOS:

Include high-quality images of your finished cosplay, preferably in the same environment as the character (if possible). This gives the judges a complete view of your work and how it translates from reference to reality.

PRESENTATION TIPS

Organization:

Keep your build book organized and easy to follow. Use clear headings, bullet points, and concise descriptions. Judges should be able to quickly find information without sifting through clutter.

VISUAL APPEAL:
